- <sup>2</sup>Ascribe to the LORD the glory **of his** name;  
worship the LORD in **ho-ly** splendor.
- <sup>3</sup>The voice of the LORD is **o-ver the** waters;  
the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over **migh-ty** waters.
- <sup>4</sup>The voice of the LORD **is** powerful;  
the voice of the LORD is **full of** majesty. **R**
- <sup>5</sup>The voice of the LORD **breaks the** cedars;  
the LORD breaks the ce-**dars of** Lebanon.
- <sup>6</sup>He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young **wild** ox.
- <sup>7</sup>The voice of the LORD flashes forth **flames of** fire.
- <sup>10</sup>The voice of the LORD **shakes the** wilderness;  
the LORD shakes the wilderness **of Ka-**desh.
- <sup>11</sup>The voice of the LORD causes the oaks to whirl, and strips the **for-est** bare;  
and in his temple **all say**, "Glory!" **R**
- <sup>13</sup>The LORD sits enthroned **o-ver the** flood;  
the LORD sits enthroned as **king for-**ever.
- <sup>14</sup>May the LORD give strength **to his** people!  
May the LORD bless his peo-**ple with** peace! **R**
